Purpose: To provide 10 & under swimmers an opportunity to see their progress prior to the championship meets in March.

Facilities: This meet will be run in an eight lane competitive pool with adjustable bulkhead, and fully automatic timing. Adjustable bulkhead allows for 25 yard course with a five lane 25 yard warm down area The starting end has a depth of 13 feet. The facility is equipped with Adolph Keiffer Wave Eater lane lines, Colorado Timing System, Agua Grip electronic pads, a ten-line readout scoreboard. and Seating for up to 500 swimmers on deck and spectator balcony seating for up to 375. Free parking next to the building. The water depth at the turn end of the pool is 5 feet. We will be using Hy-Tek meet management software. There will be no "Seeding Area" to stage swimmers. All coaches are responsible to seed their swimmers are behind the blocks. The host team will have volunteers behind the blocks to double check swimmers are in the proper lanes.

This meet is open to all Entries: swimmers that are registered members with the clubs/YMCA's invited. Each swimmer may swim a maximum of four (4) individual events. The swimmers age will be determined as of February 11, **2024.** All entries should be submitted on disk using the Hy-Tek Team Manager or **Team Unify software**. The file containing the events for this meet may be downloaded from our web site www.wsyswim.org. HY TEK LITE: We have information on the final page of this meet entry about a HY-Tek product that is FREE (TM-Lite). This product will assist you in completing your electronic entry. Entries, for which a swimmer has no time, must be entered with a NT. The number of entries for this meet will be limited to 250 athletes!!!

Entries should be e-mailed, and payment must follow within six (6) business days.

<u>Closing Date</u>: Entries must be received no later than <u>Monday, February</u> <u>5, 2024</u>. *Entries will be taken on a first come-first serve basis until we reach* 250 athletes.

Entry Fees: \$8.00 per individual event. (NOTE: If you will NOT be entering using the Hy-Tek/Team Unify software, the entry fee is \$10.00 per individual event). 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Meet Rules: The Alyson Chick Memorial 10 & Under Meet is governed by the current 2024 USA Swimming Technical Rules. All events will be timed finals. There will be no false start. It will be the coach's responsibility to get their swimmers to the starting blocks. We **will not** be using a gymnasium at this meet. All swimmers will be on the pool deck

PRE-MEET SCREENINGS - It is the responsibility of each team to screen athletes for potential exposure to COVID-19 during the week prior to the meet. By entering this meet, swimmers, as well as their coaches and families, agree that they will not attend the meet (including as spectators) if any of the following are true: the athlete or person who resides in the home of the athlete tests positive for COVID-19, is awaiting results from a COVID-19 test, exhibits symptoms of COVID-19, believes he/she has COVID-19, has travelled to a COVID-19 "hotspot" in the prior two weeks, or has come into close contact with someone with COVID-19. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever within the past three (3) days; runny nose, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; chills; diarrhea; vomiting; nausea; headache; loss of taste and/or smell; other flulike symptoms.

The West Shore YMCA has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management. Currently, the facility and HOST TEAM have no additional requirements nor spectator limitations. Compliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, Middle Atlantic Swimming, CVSD, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the event.

Awards: For individual events: Custom made Medals (1st-3rd) finishers. Custom made ribbons will be awarded for 4th-16th place finishers for individual events. Heat ribbons will be awarded for all heat winners, and each participant in the meet will be given a participation ribbon.

Meet Announcements - All pre-meet announcements including warm-up times/lanes, teams participating, meet psych sheets, and other pre-meet information may be found on our web site. www.wsyswim.org. All results, and coaches download files will be posted on our web site immediately following the meet. We will NOT mail printed results.

We will not have printed programs for spectators. A "QR Code" will be available to download heat sheets for each session

Volunteer Timers: All teams will be required to provide timers based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet. Timer assignments will be distributed after registration has closed

All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming, YMCA or PIAA. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area 40 minutes prior to the start of each session Directions - FROM THE NORTH & EAST:

Route 81 going south – proceed to the Mechanicsburg /route 114 exit(57) - turn left off ramp – continue to route 11 south Carlisle Pike) – turn right & proceed approximately 2 miles to the Cumberland Valley Educational Park. The pool is located in front of the gym.

FROM THE WEST & SOUTHWEST: Route 81 going north – proceed to the Mechanicsburg route 114 exit(57) –turn R.H. at end of ramp– continue to route 11 south (Carlisle Pike) turn right & proceed approximately 2 miles to the Cumberland Valley Educational Park. The pool is located in front of the gym.

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FROM THE SOUTH & FROM THE PA TURNPIKE: Route 83 north to the Camp Hill exit – that puts you on route 581 west – continue on 581until it joins with 81 south – proceed to the Mechanicsburg /route 114 exit(57). Turn left at the end of ramp onto route 114 –continue to route 11 south (Carlisle Pike) turn right & proceed approximately 2 miles to the Cumberland Valley Educational Park.
