MISCELLANEOUS

This meet is Open to INVITED TEAMS ONLY and will have a maximum of 200 athletes at any session with a 3.5 hour timeline. Scratches will be taken on the day of the meet, and we will re print heat sheets for coaches. Meet Program will be on Meet Mobile. There is no penalty for swimmers that are not scratched and then do not swim their event.

There will be in person spectator viewing. Spectators will use restrooms in the lobby area of the University. Boys and Girls locker rooms are strictly for use by athletes.

PRE-MEET SCREENINGS - It is the responsibility of each team to screen athletes for potential exposure to COVID-19 during the week prior to the meet. By entering this meet, swimmers, as well as their coaches and families, agree that they will not attend the meet (including as spectators) if any of the following are true: the athlete or person who resides in the home of the athlete tests positive for COVID-19, is awaiting results from a COVID-19 test, exhibits symptoms of COVID-19, believes he/she has COVID-19, has travelled to a COVID-19 "hotspot" in the prior two weeks, or has come into close contact with someone with COVID-19. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever within the past three (3) days; runny nose, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; chills; diarrhea; vomiting; nausea; headache; loss of taste and/or smell; other flulike symptoms.

The West Shore YMCA has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management. Currently, the facility and HOST TEAM have no additional requirements nor spectator limitations. Compliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, Middle Atlantic Swimming, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the event.
